1.) PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. How will this Project meet the needs of the community?

The Library has been built but not completely outfitted. Essentials still needed are as follows:

A.) WATER

.1) Water tank for potable water on the premises.

We have constructed the library designing a small tower in contemplation of obtaining future support for installation of a fresh water tank atop the facility. Plumbing to the 3 floors of the library will be part of this.

.2) Toilet facilities on the first and second floor.

Currently we have a single facility outside the building that is insufficient to serve the need of the growing number of library patrons as word has gotten out about the existence of the library, and the English classes held there.

B.) LIBRARY MATERIALS

- .1) Computer and Printer
- .2) Globe, Maps, Reference Books and Atlases
- .3) Blackboard
- .4) Writing Tablets, Pens and Pencils, Art materials

NOTE: Art materials serve not only in offering small programs for gifted children, but also will produce paintings and cards that will be sold from a small "Library Store" we have in the premises for tourists and visitors from Phnom Penh, about 40 minutes North.

This is located in the heart of the infamous "Killing Fields" of Cambodia and Pol Pot's Khmer

Rouge. The Cambodian Art is a small part of a larger sustaining revenue and ongoing support plan that will insure continued growth and development for this library.
